### VOLUNTEERING CONDITIONS

The realization of the **Goat Community Intimate Festival**, on the **22nd, 23rd, 24th and 25th of June 2023**, implies responding to a set of demands and logistical needs during the days of the event. Thus, and in different areas, volunteering manifests itself as an essential collaboration on the part of all those who like to help and work as a team. It is also the ideal opportunity to get in touch with the backstage of this production, meet new people and contribute with their commitment and willingness to make the festival a reality. And if, for some reason, your collaboration is needed by another team, don't be surprised: preparing this event is new for everyone and there may be last-minute adjustments in which we are sure you will want to contribute!

#### **Participation as a volunteer requires the fulfillment of certain duties. Must:**

- ✓ Show up at the entrance to Retiro da Fraguinha, São Pedro do Sul (40.83359455751911, -8.158560942328696), on **June 21 of 2023, at 6 pm** for the meeting of volunteers and team coordinators.
- ✓ Perform 16 hours of volunteer work, which corresponds to 4 hours a day, and remain available throughout the festival;
- ✓ Comply with the schedules (mostly rotating) stipulated by the team coordinator, which will be announced after the volunteer meeting, with each team coordinator.

**Note:** Failure to attend the volunteer meeting may lead to exclusion.  
Applications accepted from the age of 16.

#### **The volunteers is entitled to:**

- ✓ 1 meal ticket per day;
- ✓ Entrance to the festival and access to all its activities (out of volunteer activity hours);
- ✓ Free accommodation at the festival campsite (bring your tent);
- ✓ Personal accident and civil liability insurance (during the period of performance of their functions).

After filling out the registration form available on the website (Volunteering tab), the volunteer must wait for a contact from a member of the organization, in order to confirm their participation in the festival.

**The Volunteer Teams are divided into sectors, and are as follows:**

#### **I – MANAGMENT**

- **Information and Lost and Found:** information, lost and found, *merchandising* sale, participant's battery charging management (mobile phones, cameras, etc.).

#### **II – SCHEDULE**

- **Programing Support:** support for artists, therapists and technicians, organization of space, provision of water, and other necessary materials, attention to needs of participants.

#### **III – CANTINE AND SOCIAL ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES**

- **Kitchen Helpers:** collaboration in preparing food, washing dishes, collecting waste; Keeping the entire kitchen clean and tidy.
- **Helpers in the Dining Room:** distributing meals, transporting trays to the kitchen, cleaning plates and tables, managing waste separation.

#### **IV – CONTROL AND LOGISTICS**

- **Enclosure Surveillance:** surveillance of the network and the natural space within the enclosure.
- **Camping Management and Surveillance:** attention to the well-being of those camping, provision of information to new arrivals, management of space waste.
- **Parks - Control of Access and Vehicles:** confirmation of the validity of the signs of authorized vehicles in the parking lot/s reserved for the organization, management and surveillance of the parks.
- **Cleaning and Waste Management:** garbage collection, management and organization of spaces, general cleaning of the festival areas.
